## **PRESENTATIONS**

A) San Bernardino Valley College Internship Program - Spring 2018

Ms. Roberta Perez gave a presentation on the District's Internship Program in partnership with San Bernardino Valley College (SBVC). The District developed this program with SBVC to offer hands-on experience to students studying for careers in the water industry.

Ms. Caldwell-Betties thanked the Board for partnering with SBVC and hosting their students. The Board presented Certificates of Completion to the 2018 Spring interns and congratulated them on their achievement. The Board collectively thanked Ms. Caldwell-Betties and SBVC for their partnership.

## **GENERAL MANAGER/CEO REPORTS**

A) District Updates

Mr. Martin Zvirbulis, General Manager/CEO, reported the following:

- The District recently hired Julia Metzler as a Customer Service Representative.
- The District sponsored the Los Osos High School Grizzlies Solar Cup Team for the 2018 Solar Cup Race which took place May 18-20, 2018. The team competed in the Veteran division but did not place this year. They performed well and demonstrated true commitment to the spirit of Solar Cup over the last eight months preparing for the race.
- On May 3, 2018 the District successfully issued the bonds that were approved by the Board on April 24, 2018. Market conditions were favorable, resulting in a savings of over \$4 million, which is larger than anticipated. Bond documents will be executed this week and funding will occur in early June. Staff appreciates the Board's support of this important transaction.
- CVWD has once again received the Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting (CAFR) by the Government Finance Officers Association for its comprehensive annual financial report. This award is the highest form of recognition in the area of governmental accounting and financial reporting and represents a significant accomplishment by our agency and its management. Congratulations to Carrie Corder, Chad Brantley, Agnes Boros, Jennifer Fillinger, Andrea Dutton and the entire Finance Team.
- On May 21, 2018 the Department of Water Resources increased the initial state
  water project allocations from 30% to 35% based on favorable storage
  conditions throughout the state. That forecast could change as the year
  progresses.
- Congratulations to President Curatalo who was recently re-elected to the Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO) for San Bernardino County.
